- e. Referendum Results
- f. Decision Statement
- g. Examiner's Final Letter
- h. Examiner's Final Report

2. Background

- a. Why and when was the NDP developed?
- b. Who was involved? Steering Group, Parish Council, external support etc

3. Meetings

- a. Agendas of Steering Group Meetings
- b. Minutes of Steering Group Meetings
- c. Agendas of Parish Council Meetings (with reference to NDP or other relevant information)
- d. Minutes of Parish Council Meetings (with reference to NDP or other relevant information)

4. Our Plan

- a. NDP (at all key stages eg v1 for informal comment; pre submission draft' submission draft; referendum draft; Final made)
- b. NDP Appendices/Annexes
- c. Basic Conditions Statement
- d. Consultation Statement
- e. Strategic Environmental Assessment (if applicable)



- 5. Evidence Base all relevant NDP files should go in this section, examples include (note, not a complete list)
 - a. Consultation Statement all evidence, for example
 - Statement of Community Involvement
 - Newsletters/magazines with notification or information regarding consultation
 - Any NDP flyers, leaflets or marketing for NDP events with photographs etc
 - Consultation letters to residents, businesses etc
 - All Surveys, community, resident, housing, business etc and results. Include dates the consultation ran from/to etc
 - Any NDP flyers or other events with photographs etc
 - Any minutes of events etc.
 - b. Terms of Reference
 - c. Site Assessments
 - d. Designated Neighbourhood Area (application letter, map and confirmation letter from Local Authority)
 - e. NDP comments from Local Authority
 - f. Regulation 14 assessment and information, e.g. decisions made etc
 - g. Examiner's letter(s)
 - h. Examiner's report(s)
 - Links to any relevant documents from Local Authorities, Local Plan.
 Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA), Strategic
 Housing Market Assessment (SHMA), Site Allocations Document etc
 - j. Link to National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF)
 - k. Other relevant documents, e.g.
 - link to 'Historic England Advice Note 1 Conservation Area
